Meeting called to order at 1908 by Lyn Carvell

Approval of January Minutes-not done, some changes need to be made, will approve at the April meeting.

Treasurer: Filing taxes this week

Showing too much of a loss with the fundraisers

Savings: \$10,494.40 Checking: \$20,000

- Baron Cup 2009 \$1900.00 check just given to MSC by McRec

Motion was made for Jen to get a consult on the Market to see how to better invest funds that are currently in a CD. All were in favor.

Field Manager: Fields will be fine to use next week or use best judgement as to what fields to practice on. Suggestion was made to have players practice in sneakers so they do not damage the fields.

Wayne getting paint to line fields.

Registrar: All players are on teams and t-shirts are ordered and should be done by the end of this month

- Lyn switched some U6 players

Aux: All fundraising is together and ready to be handed out as soon as Jen gets the practice schedules.

- Will be doing the drawstring bag with our logo on it for all players that sell 12 items or more.
- Jen G needs to do a form for Jen K regarding profit of the fundraiser
- Does the Club want to do a different fundraiser next year or stick with the same one?

Girls Lanco: Tryouts in April, will put it in the Sunday paper and Merchandiser for 3 wks

- There are 2 travel teams for Spring

Boys Lanco: Having problems with getting information from all players

- If a player is registered with another team, they must be released from that team in order to play for MSC.
- Clubs position on age appropriate/non-age appropriate?
 - Age/grade 1st, the player should prove themselves at the appropriate level at tryouts and then evaluate after tryouts based on skills.

Brooks won't be at the Tuesday tryouts because of teaching.

Lora/Lyn to check with John Berquist to see if he is willing to help

Can some of the forms be combined, maybe into 2-sided forms?

Brooks to send any electronic copies to Lyn

Tryouts-Waiver form and parent information form must be signed the night of tryouts

After tryouts-all players should be contacted either way in a timely manner.

U6: Lyn contacted Angela about attending the meeting tonight. Matt is doing the schedule.

U8: Done. 6 girls teams and 4 boys teams So far positive feedback on the all girls teams, boys only complaint is that there are so few teams and they will have to play each other more.

- Matt asked if maybe a U8/U10 girls coordinator and boys coordinator positions could be made. Matt volunteered for the girls coordinator position.
- John F. said that he is teaching a course at Garden Spot on May 3rd for U8/U10 coaches to get certified. Cost is \$25.00. Coaches pay upfront and when they show proof of completion MSC will reimburse them.

Boys Rec: 1-U12 team and 2-U16/19 teams

Lora completed MSC's term as the LBYSAs scheduler

Girls Rec: U14 will change to U15, 2-U10 teams, could not get enough players for a U12 team. There is one girl playing on the U16/19 team.

Equipment Manager: waiting for equipment to come in that has been ordered.

Old Business: Training schedule to all the coaches so they can pick a time to get with John F. Need to follow up.

New Business: Recruited 3 boys for the U16/19 team, motion was made to give a scholarship to the family since all the boys are brothers. All in favor for the family to pay \$110.00 and MSC would scholarship the rest.

- Lyn had emailed all the ref's from last year and only heard back from a few, although Bill Hershey is running another Ref. Course March 18, so we may get more out of that.
- Make sure all the ref's are making calls at all levels, U8 and up, and letting the players know what they did wrong and to reinforce the rules. Lyn suggested a meeting and Brooks said he would like to speak at it as well.
- Summer Camp-STARS will be the last week in July, 26-30; no other camps are to be held at this time. If Travel wants to do a separate camp, it should go thru the Board for approval.
- Lora said that we have a lot of teams in Lanco and Red Rose right now and they are all doing well.
- Not all coaches have signed the Coaches Code, and it needs to be revised for the Lanco coaches. Playing time does not have to be equal like it does for Rec,
